Also ask them to record the phonemes by calling them out the sound and recording this in their homework books.</p> <p>Phase 5 phoneme cards will also be sent out this term and will need regular practise for recognition to read and recall to write.</p> <p><i>Weekly videos will also be sent via DOJO to help support home learning. These will include a model phonic lesson for that week and how we teach the tricky words.</i></p>
