roots – these anchor the plant into the ground and absorb water and nutrients from the soil stem – holds the plant up and carries water and nutrients from the soil to the leaves germination – when a seed starts to grow.


leaves – make food for the plant using sunlight flowers – make seeds to grow into new plants nutrients - are substances needed by living things to grow

pollinators – animals or insects which carry pollen between plants


petal – brightly coloured part of the flower that attracts insects seed dispersal – a way of moving the seeds away from the parent plant
