

## Key Vocabulary: Year 3 Science

**roots** – these anchor the plant into the ground and absorb water and nutrients from the soil

**stem** – holds the plant up and carries water and nutrients from the soil to the leaves

**germination** – when a seed starts to grow.

**leaves** – make food for the plant using sunlight

**flowers** – make seeds to grow into new plants

**nutrients** - are substances needed by living things to grow

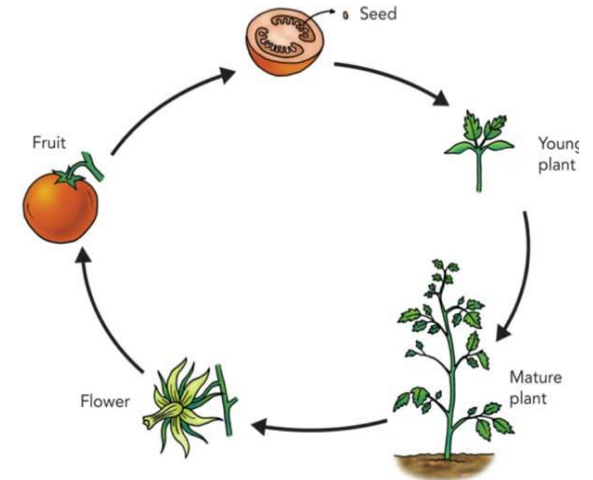
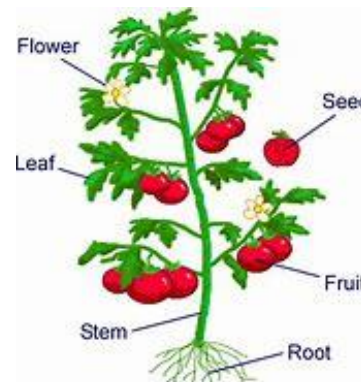
**pollinators** – animals or insects which carry pollen between plants

**petal** – brightly coloured part of the flower that attracts insects

**seed dispersal** – a way of moving the seeds away from the parent plant
