Two local women felt intimidated by police presence when they went for a walk. Covid fines are now under review.

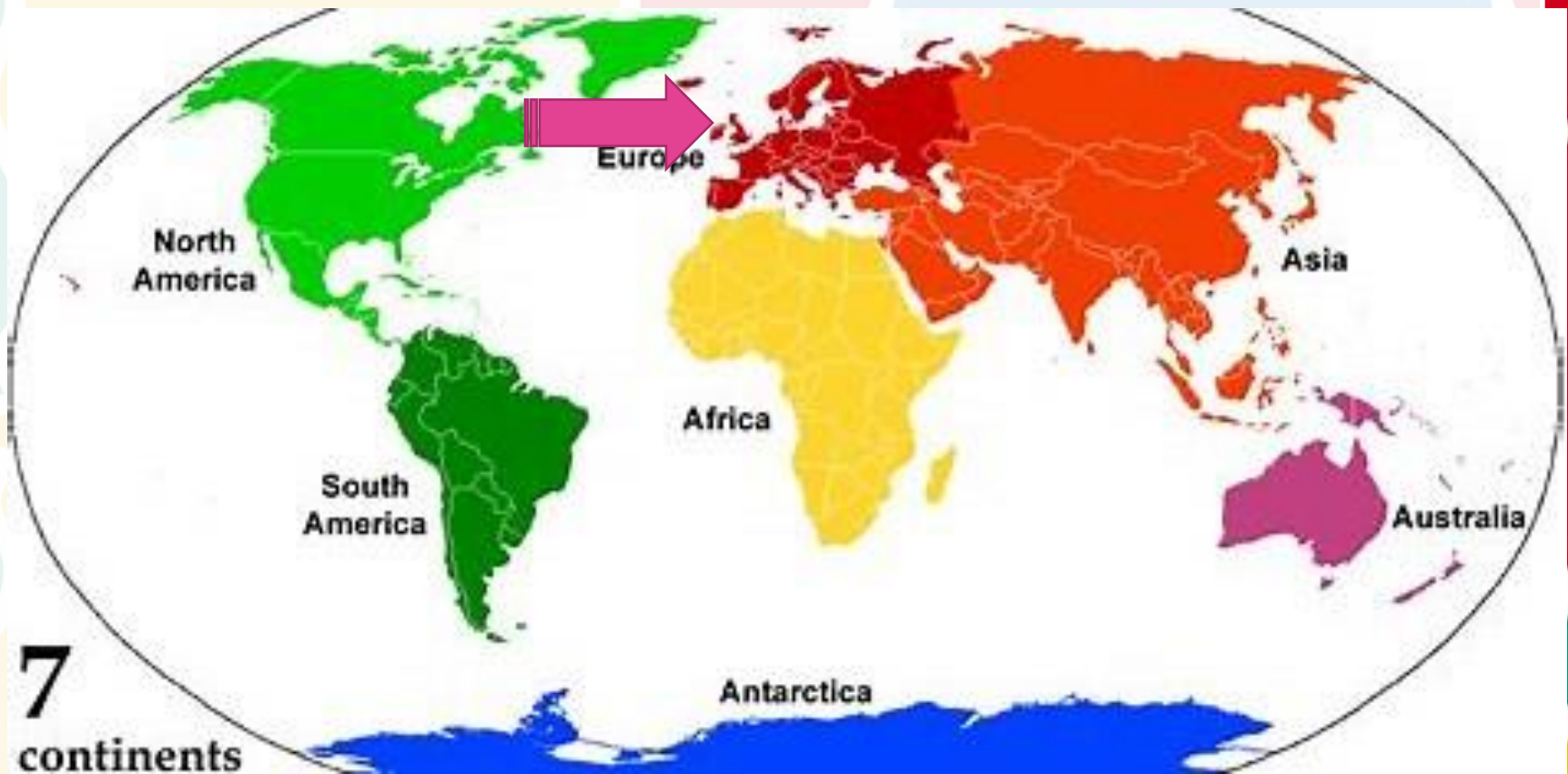

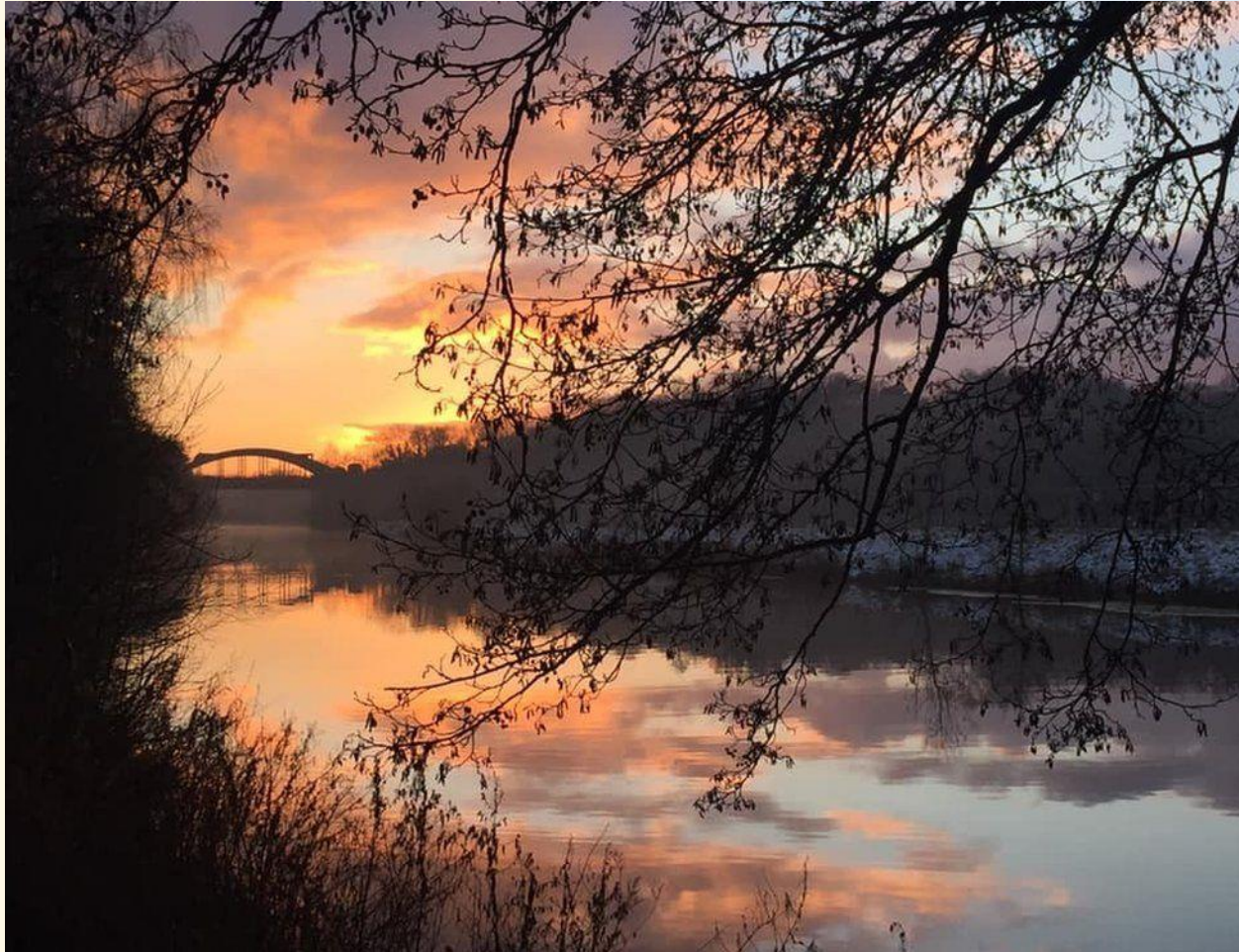

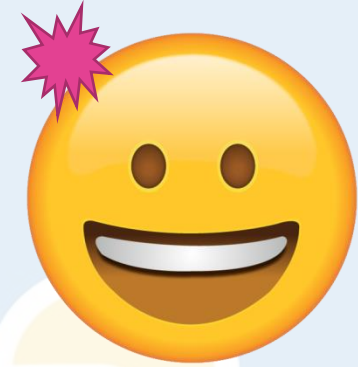
