We will be learning about Africa this term. Looking at the Big 5 Safari animals, folktales and places such as Kenya, Egypt and South Africa. We will be researching and creating fact files about savannahs, rivers and mountains. We will look at endangered animals, protecting the wildlife and the work of Nelson Mandela.
