Spellings will be given out on Friday each week for the following Thursday and consist of spellings taken from the Year One National Curriculum expectations This will be presented on handwriting paper so your child can practise their pre cursive script.	Please continue to use your Phase 5 cards to help your child recognise these phonemes by sight. Also ask them to record the phonemes by calling them out the sound and recording this in their homework books. <i>Weekly videos will also be sent via DOJO to help support home learning. These will include a model phonic lesson for that week and how we teach the tricky words.</i>

<p>This term we are looking at plants and how they grow. We will be looking to identify roots, stems, shoots, leaves and petals.</p> <p>Have you planted anything in your garden? Have you investigated what plants look like below the soil? Can you name the parts of different plants and flowers? What do plants and flowers need to grow? Can you find any of the flowering plants on your knowledge organiser?</p> <p>We will also be studying the Italian scientist Galileo. What can you find out about him?</p>	<p>This term we will be studying famous Italian artists such as Da Vinci, Michelangelo and Arcimboldo. We will also be learning about the Vatican and the Pope and a brief introduction to the Romans and mosaics.</p> <p>What can you find out about one of these people? Can you re create art like them? Can you look at where they live? Can you discover what they did to change the way we live today?</p>	<p>This term we will be listening to Italian composers and musical artists. Maybe you would like to listen to music from Puccini, Rossini and Verdi and respond to it. Or you might like to listen to Luciano Pavarotti sing and find out more about being an operatic singer? Or would you like to listen and find out more about Andrea Bocelli and how he combines English and Italian song lyrics to make beautiful music.</p>	<p>This term we are studying Italy.</p> <p>What can you find out about Italy? Food tasting? Fashion? Landmarks? Language?</p>
