*Toys have existed for thousands of years, and they were made from the materials that were available at the time.*

*Toys were mainly made of wood, paper, and metal during the Victorian age.*

*Rich Victorian children played with toys such as clockwork trains, rocking horses, tea sets and dolls.*

*Poorer children played with homemade toys such as peg dolls, wooden boats and rags stuffed with sawdust.*

*Modern toys are mainly made of plastic and many modern toys use electricity to work.*
