Vocabulary

- Amphibians** – They live in the water as babies and on land as they grow older. They have smooth, slimy skin.
- Birds** - All birds have a beak, two legs, feathers and wings.
- Fish** - They live and breathe under water. They have scaly skin, fins to help them swim and they breathe through gills
- Mammals** - They are animals that breathe air, grow hair or fur and feed on their mother's milk as a baby.
- Reptiles** - All reptiles breathe air. They have scales on their skin.
- Carnivore** - Animals that mostly eat other animals (meat).
- Herbivore** - Animals that only eat plants.
- Omnivore** - Animals that eat both plants and other animals.

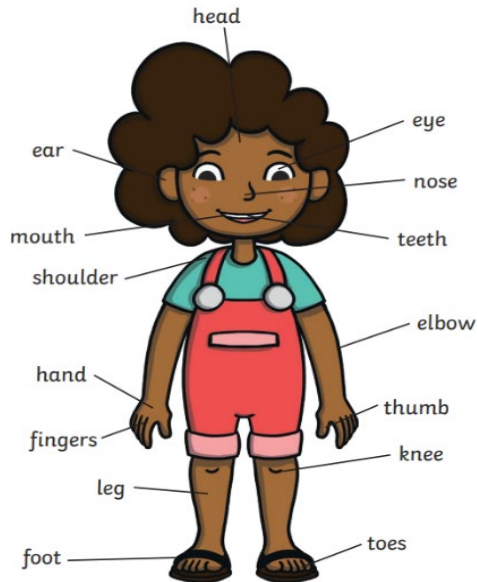
