Chronological order:
The order in which events took place in time, from first to last.

Queen Victoria:
She became Queen at 18 and reigned from 1837 - 1901.

Victorians:
People who lived in the time when Queen Victoria was queen.

Workhouses:
Places where poor people, including children, would live in exchange for working. The conditions were bad.

Industrial Revolution:
When machine manufacturing became more common. Many people began to work in factories in towns and cities.
