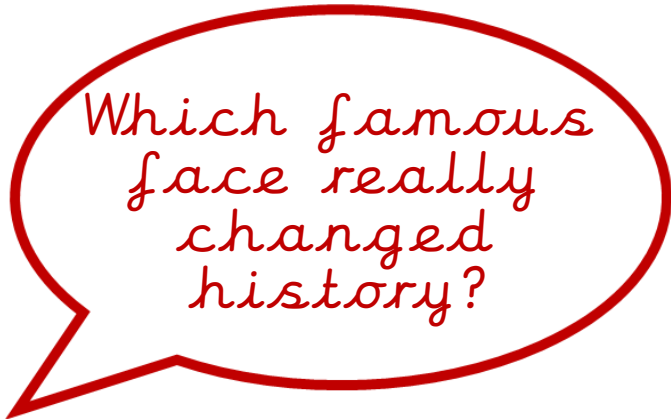

Monarch - A monarch is a king or queen, an emperor or a sultan.

Reign - The time that someone is king or queen.

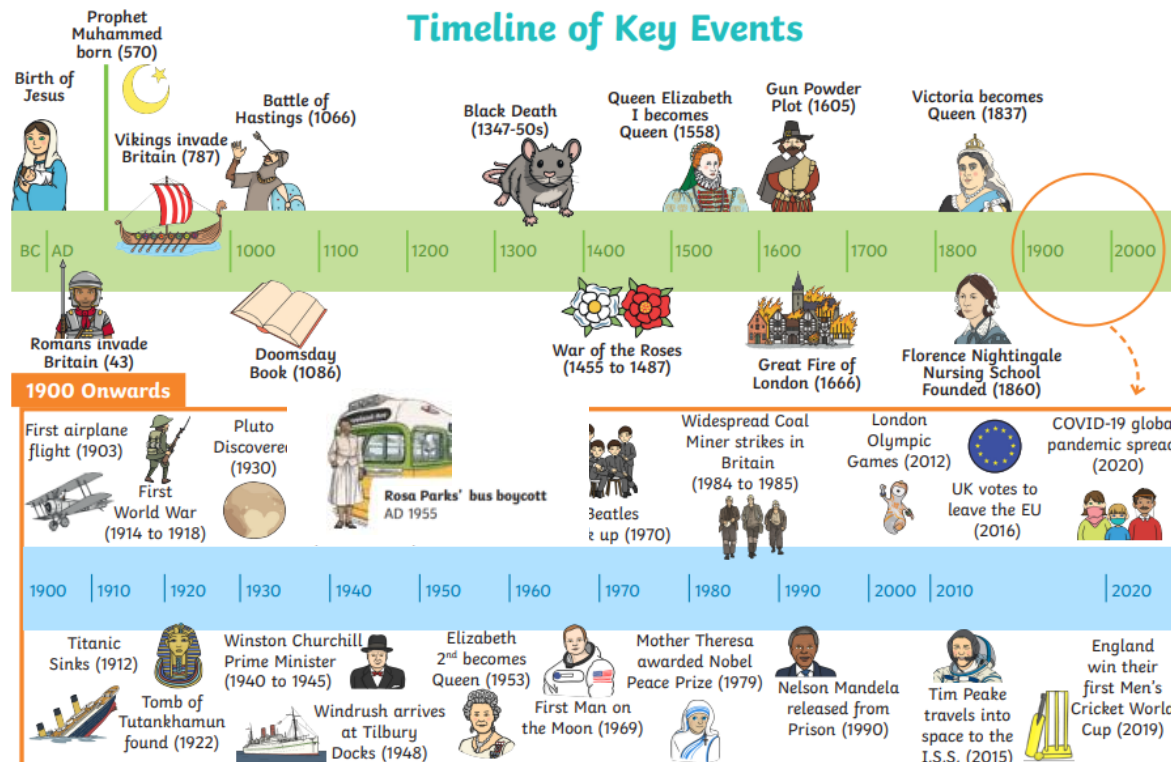
